This training is open to individuals 19 years of age and over with the priority being that this training is for people who live in Richmond, if we are unable to fill the training with interested people who live in Richmond then we may offer the course to people who do not live in Richmond on a first come, first served basis.

The core components of our training include: clinical aspects of dying, psychological aspects of dying, spirituality, and communication. Volunteers are required to complete all of the sessions of the training course. Cost is \$125.00
